TAXONOMYIC NOTE: PARAPLIOSACCOMYS WITTEORUM (RODENTIA, GEOMYIDAE), A REPLACEMENT NAME FOR PARAPLIOSACCOMYS WITTEI MARTIN, 2008

J.E. Martin (2008) named a species of geomyid rodent, *Parapliosaccomys wittei*. The trivial name was intended as a patronym for Beverly and Bernhard Witte. However, the suffix used for the trivial name was the genitive singular. Therefore, the appropriate genitive plural should be *-orum*, making the appropriate name *Parapliosaccomys witteorum*.
